Implementation Stage

Then, program preparation was carried out, which included making materials, coordinating with the school, teachers, and students, and preparing event details such as the background of the event. Students prepare for the implementation stage of the program. Mentors also prepare what will be consulted to students.

After that, the introduction of the program, materials, and apperception stage was conducted, where the participants were introduced to the concept of public speaking and its advantages. Mentors gave an introduction to the importance of public speaking training and gave examples of good practice in public speaking. The next stage was joint mentoring, where participants and mentors held discussions to identify problems faced by teachers and students, and find solutions together.

- b. Prepare a recording device such as a cell phone, microphone, or headphones to create a quality digital broadcast. The use of a good recording device can produce clear and quality sound. It is recommended that students and teachers use these tools to record the digital broadcast for better results. Be sure to monitor the recording using headphones or earphones to check the quality of the recorded audio. Also, make sure that the sound produced is of good quality so that the digital broadcast becomes more professional.
- c. After recording the sound, it is important to set up sound editing tools before publishing it. This is done to improve the audio quality and edit the editable content. Some of the most commonly used programs for audio editing are Adobe Audition, GarageBand, LogicX and Audacity.
- d. Once the recording is ready, students can upload it to free or paid podcast apps. The team recommends using the V-Mix app to download student recordings, so that students can choose whether to use free or paid podcasts.

The training and coaching of podcast implementation took 4 days for teachers and students of Madrasah Aliyah Negeri 1 Rembang. The event "Public Speaking Training for Students and Teachers of Madrasah Aliyah Negeri 1 Rembang" was attended by 50 people and went according to plan. Positive responses were obtained from teachers, principals, and students. After this activity they will better understand good and correct public speaking techniques.
